

Opening of the Center for **G**eometry and **C**omputational **D**esign

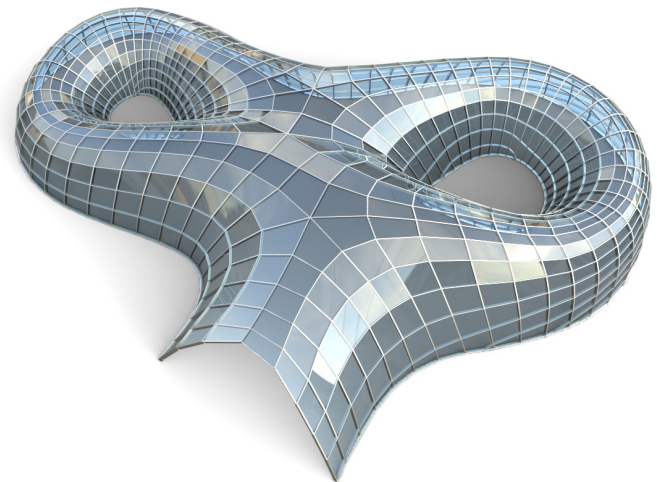
